Local MP Jack Lopresti visits SEA

Jack Lopresti, MP for Filton and Bradley Stoke, (a new constituency created in 2010) visited SEA's North Bristol Office, on 3 September. The Bristol office is located within his constituency.

Managing Director Paul Phillips and Aerospace Director Ben Olivier explained SEA's heritage and future plans. They discussed how SEA's defence and space business fits into the intersection in the South West of the aerospace and electronics sectors, and how SEA will contribute to the planned growth of the space industry - foreseen in the UK Space Innovation and Growth Strategy 2010-2030.
